For the London, Epsom or Southampton provider:

- 96 UCAS tariff points (or an equivalent level of attainment through recognised qualifications not included in the UCAS tariff*) or:
- completed an Advanced Apprenticeship in Surveying or an Advanced Apprenticeship in Construction Technical* through which a Construction and Built Environment Diploma with a minimum DD profile was obtained or through which a Construction and Built Environment Extended Diploma with a minimum MMM profile was obtained, or an equivalent qualification or:
- a current Royal Institution of Chartered Surveyors (RICS) Associate qualification (AssocRICS)
 Dates for your diary relevant employment or:
- successfully completed the UCEM BSc Access module and
- GCSE grade 4 (or C) or above in English and mathematics (If you do not have these English and maths qualifications, you will need to complete an assessment that shows you are working at Level 1 or above. You will then need to complete functional skills qualifications as part of your apprenticeship.)
- Please note that students are required to be 18 years or over at the start of their programme.
