

For the Epsom provider:

Entry to the programme of study is normally through demonstration of a minimum of 112 tariff points. Applicants must also hold GCSE grades in Maths, English and additional STEM subject at grades C, or 5, or above. Disciplines studied post GCSE must include any of Engineering or relevant STEM subjects (Physics recommended). In addition to the required entry tariff applicants must have also achieved an A level in Maths at grade B. Where required subjects are not held, applicants will be required to successfully complete a Mathematics bridge course. Apprenticeship applicants must hold an offer of employment prior to enrolling on the course.
