

For the Cardiff provider:

To enter the course, you'll need a minimum of 5 GCSEs at Grade C or above, including Mathematics at Grade B and English/Welsh First Language, or an appropriate Level 2 Diploma qualification at Merit Grade with GCSE Maths and English/Welsh First Language at C Grade.

You'll also need:

- An interest in structures and the wider urban fabric - construction isn't a job confined to the working hours of the day but rather a way of life
- An ability to work under pressure individually or as part of a team in order to complete the assignments to strict deadlines and specifications
- A reasonable grasp of mathematics is desirable, as many of the modules rely on basic mathematical principles in a construction context
- Full commitment to attendance is required, as is respect for others, enthusiasm for the subject and self-motivation.
