For the Oxford, London or Tunbridge Wells provider:

- 96 UCAS tariff points (or an equivalent level of attainment through recognised qualifications not included in the UCAS tariff) or:
- completed an Advanced Apprenticeship in Surveying or an Advanced Apprenticeship in Construction Technical* through which a Construction and Built Environment Diploma with a minimum DD profile was obtained or through which a Construction and Built Environment Extended Diploma with a minimum MMM profile was obtained, or an equivalent qualification or:
- a current Royal Institution of Chartered Surveyors (RICS) Associate qualification (AssocRICS) Dates for your diary relevant employment or:
- successfully completed the UCEM BSc Access module and:
- GCSE grade 4 (or C) or above in English and mathematics (If you do not have these English and maths qualifications, you will need to complete an assessment that shows you are working at Level 1 or above. You will then need to complete functional skills qualifications as part of your apprenticeship.) Please note that students are required to be 18 years or over at the start of their programme
