

Building Surveyor – Level 6

The entry requirements for the learning provider for this course are as follows:

Applicants must have the right to work in England, meet Education and Skills Funding Agency residency status requirements, spend at least 50% of their working hours in England and be directly employed in a job role that will enable the requirements of the apprenticeship to be achieved. In addition, you should have:

- 96 UCAS tariff points (or an equivalent level of attainment through recognised qualifications not included in the UCAS tariff*) **or**:
- completed an Advanced Apprenticeship in Surveying or an Advanced Apprenticeship in Construction Technical* through which a Construction and Built Environment Diploma with a minimum DD profile was obtained or through which a Construction and Built Environment Extended Diploma with a minimum MMM profile was obtained, or an equivalent qualification **or**:
- a current Royal Institution of Chartered Surveyors (RICS) Associate qualification (AssocRICS) Dates for your diary relevant employment **or**:
- successfully completed the UCEM BSc Access module **and**
- GCSE grade 4 (or C) or above in English and mathematics (If you do not have these English and maths qualifications, you will need to complete an assessment that shows you are working at Level 1 or above. You will then need to complete functional skills qualifications as part of your apprenticeship.)

Please note that students are required to be 18 years or over at the start of their programme.
